He began to abuse alcohol, then drugs. Their home environment was one of anger, violence, instability, and distrust. Theresa decided she and her children had to get out. She was referred to The Dwelling Place where she has received help getting a job and apartment, and support toward a better life. Theresa and her daughters appreciate your prayers as they adjust to a home of their own, new routines, and a new life.
