

“When those who have been baptized as children are ready to make a public profession of faith and accept the responsibility of life in the church (sometimes called ‘confirmation’), the session shall provide an opportunity for them to do so. They are to be instructed in the faith, examined by the session, received as active members, and presented to the congregation in public worship. At this time, they reaffirm the vows of Baptism by renouncing evil and affirming their reliance on God’s grace, professing their faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and declaring their intent to participate actively and responsibly in the worship, life, governance, and mission of the church. On such occasions, it is fitting for all worshipers to reaffirm the baptismal covenant.”





## PERSONAL STATEMENTS OF FAITH

**Anna Reese Blue:** God is the creator of heaven and earth, he is all knowing, gracious, and merciful. Jesus is the Son of God, and he died for us, which took away our sin so that we are able to go to heaven. The Holy Spirit is the spirit of God and it dwells in us. The church is a place that fellow believers can meet to worship God. The church is called to spread God's word, and to support and help others. As a disciple of Jesus Christ I am called to obey God's word, show his love to all, and to constantly be growing in my faith.

**Ayden Jonathan Fussell:** I believe God is the creator and sustainer of everyone and everything. Jesus is God's Son who redeemed us from our sins that died on the cross. The Holy Spirit is what lives inside believers and helps us do good for others. The Church is all of God's believers. Small groups of the Church get together every week and fellowship, help each other, and help the community. As a Christian, I am called to lead as an example, teach others about God, and to be a good person in general.

**Henry Elliott Moore, IV:** I believe God as the father of all things and makes everything good. We sinned, but God gave us a chance of redemption. He sent us Jesus to save us so we could be redeemed. The spirit is God entering in us. I believe the church is the family that you are connected to spiritual. **James Edwin Gale Sills, III:** I believe God created everything and has no beginning and no end. People are created by God in his image and God has love for all people. It’s hard to describe everything about God in words. God is bigger than what I can come up with. I believe Jesus is God’s son who lived on the earth like the rest of us but was still divine.
