The Affirmation of Faith: From the Study Catechism Q. 75, 76 and A Brief Statement of Faith

In what name are you baptized?

In the name of the Trinity. After he was raised from the dead, our Lord appeared to his disciples and said to them, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father

and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." What is the meaning of this name?

It is the name of the Holy Trinity.

The Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God.
And yet they are not three gods, but one God in three persons.
We worship God in this mystery.

Through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, we trust in the one triune God, the Holy One of Israel, whom alone we worship and serve.


