We desire to be Christ-like in our actions, but we can forget and follow the values and examples that this world offers us. We desire to be kind and loving, but can allow fatigue and stress to deter us from these good intentions. Forgive us, O Lord, and allow your grace to wash over us. Help us to forgive others and to forgive ourselves, and to begin anew, each day. Hear us now, in the silence of these moments, as we confess to you what is ours alone to confess. . .
