"Holy Conversations" Sunday, February 22 Wallace Presbyterian Church Sanctuary 3:00 - 4:30 p.m.



Pastors, churches, and our Presbytery all face important decisions about how to vote on the General Assembly's actions regarding same-gender marriage. Before we debate and vote on the proposed amendments on March 7, our Presbytery wants to encourage a time of discernment through "holy conversations" – conversations which intentionally make room for the Holy Spirit.

Two pastors, Jim Randall (MacPherson PC/Fayetteville) and Ernie Thompson (First PC/ Wilmington) have been asked to share their perspectives on same-gender marriage in the church and engage in such a holy conversation at three locations in the Presbytery.
