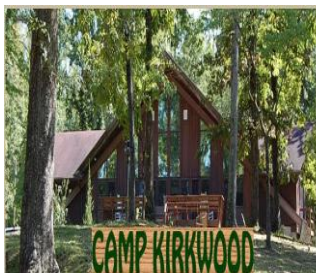


**WPC Children's Church**
