ACTIONS OF THE SESSION

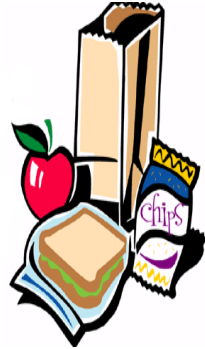
At the Tuesday, January 21 meeting of the session, the elders and minister:
