Dear Friends,

Perhaps you remember the excitement as the year 2000 approached with the beginning of a new millennium.

However, you may also remember the fears many people had about the predicted Y2K catastrophe. More soberminded predictions focused on possible glitches in computer software and the danger of an information gridlock. Other, more panicked predictions, warned of the end of the world, complete with horrendous descriptions of what would happen. Thankfully, neither scenario proved to be true.

If you were at the Wallace
Presbyterian Church during the year
2000, you probably remember our
intentional focus on the providence of
God as we celebrated God's goodness
throughout the year with special events
and worship services. The session
appointed a planning committee who
helped our congregation bear witness in
a positive way to the trust we hold in our
God, our help in ages past, our hope for
years to come.

Our year of celebration in 2000 actually began with A Service of Worship, Assurance, and Hope for God's Future on New Year's Eve, December 31, 1999. At the top of the order of worship was written, "For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations." We gathered at the Lord's Table for the Sacrament of Communion. We sang the following hymns: Abide With Me; Great Is Thy Faithfulness; and Our God, Our Help in Ages Past. The benediction said, "May Almighty God bless, preserve, and keep us, this night and forevermore. Amen. Bless the Lord. The Lord's name be praised."

Here we are, twenty years later, already one-fifth of the way through the first century of the third millennium. While many things have changed for us personally, as a congregation, and in the world, many things have remained the same such as hard times, unknown dangers, and continuing threats. For some reason, though, twenty years ago the predictions played upon the deepest fears and anxieties; maybe because of the novelty of the calendar turning over from 1999 to 2000.

What else has not changed at all is God's faithfulness, goodness, and steadfast love. Our faith in Jesus Christ calls us to meet the challenges of life with assurance and hope in God's unfailing strength and love. That is a good message to hear at this new year and every day of the year.

On Sunday afternoon, January 2, 2000, the Chancel Choir presented a Millennium Music Celebration. We sang old hymns and heard new anthems, including a new millennium "Hymn of Praise" with words by Margaret Glasgow and music by Karla Casteen. As we begin 2020, think on these words and be inspired with the sure knowledge of God's loving care and purpose: "Lord God of all, quide us through this new day. Highlight our paths to see the upward way. Focus our vision, enable us to see, Your awesome pow'r and love which shall forever be. Christ, Son of God, and Savior of mankind. Through risen glory, mortal and divine. Your saving grace both bountiful and free. Your awesome pow'r and love which shall forever be. Spirit of God, our mentor and our quide. Through mystic wonder, in each heart resides. With Father, Son, a bonded trinity. In awesome pow'r and love which shall forever be."
