From June 18 - 28, Nancy and I will be on a great adventure which we have dreamed of for twenty-five years. We will visit Seoul, South Korea where our daughter, Natalie, has been studying at Yonsei University for the 2014-2015 school year. Yonsei University was first established in 1885 by Christian missionaries. After a week of sightseeing in Seoul, the three of us will come home to the States.

While we are touring Seoul,
Nancy and I hope to see and visit
at least one of the many
Presbyterian churches.
Presbyterian missionaries from the
United States first arrived in Korea
in 1884, where they found that
Koreans already had the Bible in
their own language. The
Presbyterian Theological Seminary
was founded in 1901.

Now in its second century of ministry, the Presbyterian Church of Korea (Republic of Korea) has approximately 2.8 million members in more than 8,000 congregations. While the Presbyterian Church has grown tremendously in Korea, the Christians there also take their calling to mission very seriously

and faithfully. Approximately 800 missionaries are working in seventy-seven countries.

The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) involvement in Korea is through the Presbyterian Church in the Republic of Korea, the Presbyterian Church of Korea, and the National Council of Churches in Korea. The Presbyterian Mission Agency of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) reports, "The PC(USA) joins Korea's Christian community in a ministry that includes higher education and youth ministries, theological education, health ministries, women's and children's ministries, and peace education, reconciliation and reunification work."

Nancy and I are excited about our trip to Seoul. Thank you and the session for the time away to make this journey. You will be blessed by the preaching of Rev. Lauren Deer (June 21) and Dr. Dan Robinson (June 28). The Korean words below mean "Thank you!"


