On Ash Wednesday we began our Lenten journey with Jesus to the cross with the sign of ashes. Holy Week marks the final phase of that journey as we remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, the Last Supper and the betrayal on Maundy Thursday, the crucifixion on Good Friday, the quiet hope of Holy Saturday, and the joy of the resurrection on Easter Sunday. We invite and encourage you to participate in the special opportunities for worship and giving during this sacred season.

Sunday, **April 6**, we will celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Communion. *If you are not able to be in worship and would like to receive communion at your residence, please contact the church office and we will make those arrangements.*

The sermon, *Come As You Are*, will draw from the story of Jesus visiting in the home of his good friends, Mary and Martha, where he is received and entertained by them and teaches them about his future (John 12:1-8).

Palm Sunday, **April 13**, Beta Club lunch fundraiser after worship in fellowship hall. The funds will support those youth who have been invited to the national competition in Orlando. The sermon, *Some Saw Glory*, will draw from the triumphal entry of Jesus and his disciples into Jerusalem (Luke 19:28-40).

Good Friday, April 18, 7:00 p.m., there will be a joint evening service with the Beulaville Presbyterian Church in our sanctuary. We will remember the death of Jesus by recalling his seven last words on the cross.

Easter Sunday, April 20, we will celebrate the joy of the resurrection with flowers on the outdoor floral cross, special music from our musicians, and receive our One Great Hour of Sharing Offering. The sermon, *Coming To and From Easter*, will draw from the account of the disciples coming out to the tomb in the early morning to pay their last respects to the body of Jesus and going from the tomb amazed (John 20:1-18).

One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) helps to improve the lives of the millions of people who lack access to sustainable food sources, clean water, sanitation, education, and opportunity. OGHS supports Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, the Presbyterian Hunger Program, and Self-Development of People. - Heard a report on the March 1 Coastal Carolina Presbytery meeting which included a vote on the proposed amendments to the Book of Order.
- Began organizational plans to host the May 31 East Community Gathering of the Presbytery: parking, greeters, registration, snack and lunch arrangements, worship and audio visual needs, and clean up.
- Approved vacation for the interim pastor (4/21-27) and the Rev. Dr. Robert "Bob" Thompson to preach on Sunday, April 27.
- Approved the Beta Club fundraiser lunch at the church and the use of a Sunday School class room on Thursday afternoons through the end of the school year for a student robotics team.
- Asked for elders to serve communion on April 6 and participants for the Joint Good Friday Service.
- Began discussion for a Youth Sunday Service and recognition of a high school senior.
- Approved plans to serve families in need through the school system during holy week.
- Received correspondence that the Red Cross will not be able to use our facility for a Designated Emergency Shelter because of our use on Sundays but would be glad to offer their educational programs at our church.
- Shared concerns for those in our church and community and adjourned with prayer.
