FEED OUR HUNGRY CHILDREN BACKPACK MINISTRY OFFERING RESUMES Sunday, August 25



Our monthly Feed Our Hungry Children/Backpack Ministry Offering resumes on Sunday, August 25. During the 2023-2024 school year, the following schools were served: Beulaville Elementary, Chinquapin Elementary, Rose Hill-Magnolia Elementary, Wallace Elementary, and Wallace-Rose Hill High School. A total of 6,186 backpacks of food were provided over the weekends, 900 backpacks were provided over the summer, totaling 7,086 backpacks!
