### Alley Hart

Played for Bones McKinney at Wake Forest and was a guard on the 1960 ACC Championship team.



### Jim Moore

One of Dean Smith's first recruits at UNC, named as the most inspirational player his senior year, and a member of the Greater Wilmington Sports Hall of Fame.



### Eddie Biedenbach

Played for Norm Sloan at NC State and was part of two of the most memorable games in ACC Tournament History, point guard in the 12-10 win over Duke in 1968, and as assistant coach when State beat Maryland in 1974 on the way to the National Championship.
