

Dear WPC family,

I'm excited about sharing the Advent and Christmas seasons with you this year! Advent is the first season in the church calendar. And while Advent is the beginning of a new church year, it never really feels like a beginning to me. It feels more like an end. In the gospel text for the first Sunday in Advent, Mark uses dramatic apocalyptic images to describe the end of time.

I'll be the first to admit that I'm more than a little uncomfortable talking about end times. The topic has been so severely abused, often used to evoke a response through fear. Unfortunately, that has meant that many of us have ignored the topic all together, but Mark won't let us ignore it.

All of us have had times when it felt like our whole world had come to an end only to discover, amid all the chaos and disruption, that God was drawing near. We thought we wouldn't make it through the night but discovered that God was ushering in a new day.

God will come. God will be with us. God will draw near and interrupt our lives in order to redeem us. Here in the darkness, Advent gives us light and hope to live as those who have seen something about tomorrow which the world has not yet seen and that future has a name and a face, and his name is Jesus.

Beloved, be alert, look up, your redemption is drawing near.

"What Star Is This, with Beams So Bright?" by Charles Coffin

Charles Coffin was a French university professor who wrote many poems—including about 100 hymns and a song about champagne. In 1736, he penned what may be his most famous poem. Later translated into English by John Chandler, this poem still resonates in Christmas-loving hearts today. How he would marvel that his humble words continue to inspire worship of the Newborn King!

What star is this, with beams so bright, More lovely than the noonday light? 'Tis sent to announce a newborn king, Glad tidings of our God to bring.
