## Wallace Presbyterian Bone Marrow Donor Drive In Honor of Wright Lanier and his Family Sunday, February 20, 2011 9:30 am to 1:00 pm

Every day, thousands of patients with leukemia and other life-threatening diseases hope for a bone marrow donor who can make a life-saving transplant possible. Seventy percent do not match a donor in their family. They depend on the “Be the Match Registry” (formerly, National Bone Marrow Registry), which is the largest registry in the world to find a life saving donor. A generous 19 year old donor who had been a part of the registry has given our own Wright Lanier a chance for a healthy life.

Guidelines for joining the “Be The Match Registry” are fairly simple: Be between the ages of 18 and 60, be willing to donate to any patient in need, and meet the health guidelines. On the day of the drive, paper work including health information and an agreement will be signed and the donor will swab the inside of his/her cheek. That is it!

If you are fortunate enough to be a potential match, you will be contacted for additional testing to insure the best match has been found. The patient’s physician will decide if the donation will be by peripheral blood stem cells, which is similar to blood donation (majority) or by marrow collection from the pelvis under anesthesia. The side effects of both procedures are minimal. The donor’s expenses are covered.

It costs Be The Match over \$100 to register each donor. The registry has corporate donors to cover about 1/2 of the process. The congregation has been asked to raise \$52.00 per donor to help to defray the costs. Pew pocket envelopes are available for donations.

# FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends,

On behalf of the session, I would like to offer our heartfelt gratitude for your generosity in 2010. Following our church treasurer's year-end report at the January 18 session meeting, the elders and I agreed that we needed to highlight Wayne's report. You can see a print copy elsewhere in this newsletter.

As of December 31, 2010, the congregation had contributed, through pledge giving, loose offerings, and Sunday School collections, \$282,897.57, or 100.02% of the 2010 budget of \$282,855. Total budget disbursements for 2010 were \$269,431.57, or 95.25%. The budget net for 2010 was \$13,466.

On top of your generous support of the general budget, you also contributed \$10,595.08 to special offerings throughout the year, such as One Great Hour of Sharing, the Christmas Joy Offering, P.A.T.H. (Presbyterian Answer to Hunger), Feed Our Hungry Children, and several others.

At a time when many churches are cutting budgets, decreasing benevolences, curtailing programs, and reducing staff, it is quite commendable that you exceeded the 2010 budget and contributed above and beyond through special offerings.

Our Christian stewardship, however, involves much more than just meeting a line-item budget. The session has presented us with a true

challenge budget for 2011 of \$300,000. This amount includes an undesignated amount of approximately \$15,000 in the benevolence section. The session's vision is for all of us to give faithfully in response to God's grace in Jesus Christ, so that we can determine how best to use the \$15,000 in mission outreach and support. Your generous and faithful support will help our congregation go beyond what we have typically done outside the walls of our church.

Thank you for your generous support in 2010! Thank you to the session for setting a vision and challenge before us in 2011! Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift of Jesus Christ, and for his call to us to be faithful stewards and disciples of the riches of his grace and mercy.


