Dear Friends,

The March 2020 newsletter contained an announcement about our guest preachers for March 15 and March 22. Rev. Cynthia Williams was scheduled to be in the pulpit on the fifteenth and Ruling Elder Jay Bender from Pollocksville was scheduled to preach on March 22. They were going to fill in for me following my shoulder replacement surgery on Tuesday, March 10. However, on Friday and Saturday, March 13 & 14, the elders and I had to confer and make a decision about suspending in person worship for March 15 as the coronavirus pandemic was starting to make its presence known.

That Sunday afternoon we had a called session meeting in the Fellowship Hall at which we talked about worship and other activities at the church in light of the pandemic. We decided not to have in person worship throughout March 2020. Later that month we had another session meeting and decided to extend that moratorium through April, which included Easter. At the time, I thought we might have to follow that plan through the end of May, perhaps into June a bit. My hunch is that's what the elders thought, also.

Here we are, one year later. While we resumed in person worship on September 6, 2020, obviously things are not "back to normal" (whatever that means). The roll-out of the vaccines holds promise that later this year life might be more recognizable, but who knows?

In the meantime, we struggle through this pandemic that affects every single one of us. I and my minister colleagues share the same questions and concerns that many of you have about what church will be like "after the pandemic" (whatever that means). Again, who knows? However, what we do know is this — God calls us to be the church in all times and in all seasons. The season of Lent is a good reminder of how dependent we are on God's grace and mercy and power, all of which enable us to keep on keeping on being the church of Jesus Christ.

* approved a request from the Alternative Sunday School Class to use the curriculum

* approved the 2020 annual statistical report;

* approved a recommendation from the Worship & Music Ministry Team to pre-record the Good Friday worship service for April 2 and to conduct a congregational survey to determine estimated attendance at Easter Sunday worship (to help with planning);

* prayed for members of the congregation and the community;

* were led in a closing prayer by Elder Fred Burroughs.

P.A.T.H. OFFERING Presbyterian Answer to Hunger Sunday, March 7



Using readings, Bible study, videos, and discussion we will cover the following topics: Who is God? Who are we? God in relationship; God who saves; God of action; God of belonging.


WON'T YOU JOIN US ON MARCH 7?
