

Wallace Presbyterian Women World Day of Prayer 2025 "I Made You Wonderful!" *Psalm 139:14*

Friday, March 7, at 10:00 am Wallace Methodist Church



We will celebrate World Day of Prayer 2025 on Friday, March 7, at 10:00 am, in the Fellowship Hall at Wallace Methodist Church. Wallace Presbyterian Women will provide the program entitled "I Made You Wonderful!" based on Psalm 139:14, prepared by the women of Cook Islands.

The service this year shares the stories of three different generations of Christian women from Cook Islands, who have shared stories of their struggle during Covid-19, of devaluation of their culture and the improvements in obstetric health care. Based on the words of Psalm 139, and woven within the stories, this worship service invites us to recognize that God created each one of us with great attention and loving care.

World Day of Prayer begins on the international dateline, in Samoa. Early in the morning, Christian women begin praying for our world. As the earth rotates, a great wave of prayer begins to build. It sweeps across the Pacific, touching Fiji and New Zealand, rolling on through Asia: Japan, the Philippines, Korea, and Bangladesh. The countries of Africa, and the Middle East are next. The wave reaches the shores of Europe as the day dawns there. Across the Atlantic, it moves onwards, the Caribbean, the Americas, and on the Pacific again until the sun finally sets over American Samoa where the final service takes place. A worldwide circle of prayer is complete.

Please plan on attending World Day of Prayer 2025 at Wallace Methodist Church. Engage in a worldwide wave of prayer for our world! Everyone is welcome.



Dear Friends,

Some of us did not grow up in a church that celebrated the season of Lent. However, it is the way that Christians have prepared themselves for the celebration of Easter for centuries. "What is most helpful for all Christians and Presbyterians to remember is that the time of Lent came into being after Easter was decided upon as an annual celebration," according to Jennifer Lord, professor at Austin Presbyterian Seminary. Lent was designed, therefore, to help prepare people to be baptized on Easter.

Lent is the 40 days (not counting Sundays) from Ash Wednesday to Easter. Sundays are not counted because they represent the resurrection of the Lord. 40 is a significant number in the Scriptures - it depicts an important period of time between God and His people, i.e. Noah and the flood, Moses and the Israelites in the wilderness, Jesus' temptation in the desert.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5. On that day from 12 noon - 1:00 pm, the sanctuary will be open for quiet meditation and to receive the imposition of ashes, if you'd like. A resource with scriptures and prayers will be provided. You're welcome to come and go during that hour as your schedule permits. The ashes remind us of the consequences of our sin which is death.

During Lent we remember and respond to the atoning death of Christ so that we may rise with Him. Thus, it is appropriate to give up something for Lent (dying) and to take on an opportunity to serve (rising). Here are some questions to consider during Lent (taken from our Baptismal Service):

- Trusting in the gracious mercy of God, do you turn from the ways of sin and renounce evil and its power in the world?
- Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Lord and Savior, trusting in his grace and love?
- Will you be Christ's faithful disciple, obeying his Word and showing his love?

May this Lent be a season to deepen our commitment to Christ and our neighbors.

ACTIONS OF THE SESSION

At the Tuesday, February 18, 2025 stated session meeting, the elders and minister

- Heard a presentation from Kira Reyna of the Red Cross on the possibility of WPC becoming a Designated Emergency Shelter. Concerns were expressed about how this might impact our activities on Sunday mornings. We will continue the conversation but shared that Duplin Disaster Relief and Charity Rebuild are other agencies that should be contacted.
- Debbie Price will be WPC's commissioner to the Presbytery Meeting on March 1 at McPherson Presbyterian, Fayetteville. The proposed amendments to the constitution will be voted on at that meeting. A majority of the 166 presbyteries must approve before an amendment becomes part of the Book of Order.
- A Vision Summit will be held on March 15 at Graves Memorial Presbyterian to discuss the restructuring of the presbytery.
- The East Community Gathering of the Presbytery will be held at WPC on May 31.
- Rev. Laura L. Lupton is now the Bridge Associate General Presbyter for Mission Coordination and Associate Stated Clerk of the Presbytery.
- There will be a called meeting of the Session on Sunday, March 9, 10:30 am in the Dining Room for the purpose of receiving new members.
- The home page on the website has been updated and includes our vision and mission statement.
- The Pastor Nominating Committee has posted our Mission Discernment Profile on the Church Leadership Connection website and has begun receiving Personal Discernment Profiles from potential candidates.
- The Outreach Committee is exploring ways for WPC to meet the needs of families in our schools all year round in addition to Christmas time.
- Presbyterian Women expressed interest in a project to make the portico door handicap accessible.
- There will be an Ash Wednesday drop-in service in the sanctuary from 12 noon 1 pm.
- Souper Bowl of Caring offering collected \$642. The proceeds will go to our Helping Hands Food Pantry.
- The meeting was closed with prayer.



We hope you will join us as we seek opportunities to worship and to be of service to our Church. Playing bells is not only fun but a joyous way to praise the Lord!


