Beloved,

Thanks to your hard work, faithfulness, prayers, and patience we are making great strides in the steps to call WPC's next installed pastor. We have completed steps 1-4 and are currently working on step 5.

- 1. WPC's Session authorized a Transitional Ministry Team (*Kristin Cottle, Geneva Maready, Devan Riley, Jason Rouse, Dan Robinson, and Lindsay Skidmore*) to complete a Mission Study. The study included meeting with community leaders and partners to hear their hopes and dreams for our community, the Holy Cow! Congregational Assessment Tool, and the feedback session with the congregation.
- 2. The Session and Transitional Ministry Team drew from the information in the Mission Study and created a Mission Statement that will be used in the Mission Discernment Profile (MDP).
- 3. The Session received permission from the Commission on Ministry (COM) to form a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC).
- 4. The Wallace Presbyterian Church's 2024 Nominating Committee placed in nomination for a congregational vote a slate of candidates representative of the whole congregation to serve on the PNC: *Wayne Casteen, Sandy Cobb, Miller Ludlum, Ellie Newton, Debbie Price, Dan Robinson, Jim Sills, Curt Simpson, & Lindsay Skidmore.*
- 5. The PNC has been elected and has begun meeting to prepare a MDP of our church's mission and the position description.
- 6. After the MDP has been approved by the COM, it will be submitted to the Church Leadership Connection (CLC) system. This is how candidates will discover WPC's position opening.
- 7. The PNC will receive matches and referrals of potential candidates from the CLC, and conduct interviews.
- 8. Once a candidate has been selected and COM has approved the call, the Session will call for a meeting of the congregation to vote on the pastoral candidate. When elected, WPC will welcome its next installed pastor!

Please keep the Pastor Nominating Committee and our church in your prayers!

At the Tuesday, October 22, 2024 session meeting, the elders and minister:

- * were led in an opening devotion and prayer by Elder Sandy Cobb;
- * Stanley Skidmore and Chad Savage shared about the scouting program. WPC holds the charter for Cub Scout Pack 35. They're meeting in the fellowship hall on Sundays at 5 pm. 40 Scouts are participating in the Pack!
- * Wayne Casteen, Treasurer, reviewed the financial statements for the first three quarters of 2024. The 2025 budget was approved and will be presented at the Annual Meeting of the Congregation and Corporation on November 17.
- * Moderator Robert Lapp, reported that the Pastor Nominating Committee will hold their first meeting on October 23 at 7 pm and the Church Wide Nominating Committee will be elected at the Annual Meeting on November 17. He led a discussion of chapter 7 *From Rowboat to Sailboat: Raising the Sail from* Joan Gray's book, *Sailboat Church*.
- * **Stewardship/Finance** \$5,000 was designated for each of the following organizations providing relief efforts from Hurricane Helene: Black Mountain Presbyterian Church, Presbyterian Diasaster Assistance, and the families from WPC who've been serving those in Western NC.
- * **Building and Grounds -** The outside painting/repair project received funding to move forward. Approval was granted to the Wallace Rose Hill Friends of the Arts to use our facility on February 2, 2025.
- * **Outreach** Approved promoting a volunteer program with for students at Wallace Elementary School.
- * **Christian Education -** Shared about the work of the Youth Council and the upcoming fellowship event at Battle Park (Laser Tag).
- * **Congregational Care** The church will provide the meat for the luncheon on November 17 and the congregation will supply the sides and desserts.
- * Worship Advent Services & Lunches will be at noon on December 5, 12, and 19. 12/5, 12/12, 12/19.
- * The meeting was adjourned with prayer.

These sister organizations were both founded by the Presbyterian Synod. The name chosen for the newly formed, merged organization was Children's Hope Alliance: an alliance forged by our deeply rooted mission to provide hope and healing for hurting children and families.
