

As the days grow shorter and the nights grow longer during the season of Advent we light candles to remind us of the light of Christ coming into the world. *The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overtake it - John 1:5.*

Each Sunday in Advent we light a candle:

HOPE - 1st Sunday, November 30

PEACE - 2nd Sunday, December 7

JOY - 3rd Sunday, December 14

LOVE - 4th Sunday, December 21

This year we would like for you, the congregation, to help us express the meaning of these four candles through your photographs which will be shown during the Advent worship services. This will be a fun and creative way for us to reflect on the meaning of HOPE, PEACE, JOY, and LOVE through each other's eyes.

At the Tuesday, October 20, 2025 stated session meeting:

- Devan Riley offered the opening devotion and prayer.
- Approved the budget for 2026 which will be presented to the congregation at the November 16 Congregational Meeting. It reflects a 2.88% increase over 2025.
- Sandy Cobb presented a report from the October 4 presbytery meeting. The Rev. Eduardo Moreno was recognized for his faithful ministry and his upcoming retirement at the end of the year.
- Robb invited the session and congregation to join him on a zoom meeting sponsored by the presbytery 30 Day Growth Plan.
- The session elected Devan Riley to be its representative on the 2026 nominating committee and gave names to Robb to ask for an elder not currently serving on session (Christy Johnson has agreed to serve).
- Approved Jim Sills to preach on November 23 while Robb and Vickie attend their niece's wedding in GA.
- Approved Scout Sunday to be held on February 8, 2026.
- Approved Rise Against Hunger to be held on March 21, 2026.
- Approved Robb to offer a confirmation class in the winter/spring of 2026 for the 12 students in 6-8 grade.
- Plans for Advent and Christmas are on their way. The Thursday 12 noon Community Advent Services and Lunches will be on December 4, 11, and 18. The choir will present their cantata on December 7. The children and youth will present their musical on December 14.
- Announced the youth schedule for the year which offers opportunities in worship, service, fellowship, and study. A mission week with CROSS Missions (Myers Park Presbyterian Church, Charlotte) is scheduled for July 19-24.
- Approved sponsoring 4 families again this year for the St. Nicholas Project. Kelli Norris has agreed to be the coordinator for WPC.
- Karla Casteen announced a meeting with Dwight Hall and an architect is being scheduled to discuss the possibility of building a columbarium.
- Joys and concerns were shared and the meeting was adjourned with prayer.

Children's Hope Alliance has hundreds of years of experience helping children and families in need—dating back to the late 1800s. In April of 2014, Barium Springs Home for Children and Grandfather Home for Children came together in an effort to have a greater impact in helping children and families across North Carolina. These sister organizations were both founded by the Presbyterian Synod. The name chosen for the newly formed, merged organization was Children's Hope Alliance: an alliance forged by our deeply rooted mission to provide hope and healing for hurting children and families.




Wednesday Mornings
