WHO ARE PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN?

Membership in Presbyterian Women (PW) is open to all women. PW members are those who choose to participate in or be supportive of Presbyterian Women in any way.

Presbyterian Women intentionally seeks the membership of women from all racial ethnic groups so that the organization may reflect a vision of the whole church as “a community of mutual interdependence in which diversity contributes to wholeness.”

WALLACE PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN BY-LAWS

1. The Wallace Presbyterian Women will seek to follow the by-laws governing the Presbyterian Women in the PC (USA).
2. Local by-laws may be changed by a simple majority vote at an announced general gathering.
3. The WPW Coordinating Team shall consist of the following officers, committees, communicators, chairs and moderators: PW Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Secretary, Treasurer, Historian, Advent Committee, Bereavement Committee, PW Gatherings/ Senior Breakfast Committee, Sanctuary Flower Committee, Missions & Issues Communicators, Search & Leadership Communicators, Spiritual Nurturer, Circle Chairs, Bible Moderators.
4. Members of the WPW Coordinating Team shall be elected for two-year terms by a simple majority at the Spring PW Gathering. If possible, terms of team members should be staggered in order that half the team is in its first year of service, and the other half is in its second year of service. The installation of the new Wallace Presbyterian Women Coordinating Team shall be held at the Fall PW Gathering.
5. There shall be at least two Presbyterian Women general gatherings each year.
6. The program and budget year shall be from September to August.
7. The status (inactive, active, affiliate) of any woman in the Wallace Presbyterian Church may be changed at any time by a request to the vice-moderator.
8. Standing Committees shall be the following:
 - Search Committee: Search and Leadership Communicator
One representative from each circle
 - Budget Committee: Treasurer-elect
Past Treasurer
Moderator-elect
 - Handbook Committee: Moderator-elect & past
Vice Moderator-elect & past
Search & Leadership Communicator-elect & past
 - By-Law Committee: Moderator
Vice Moderator
 - Historical Room Comm: Historian- One Representative from each circle

Presbyterian Women (PW) is an independent organization within the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) of more than 300,000 women. The programming and resource options for the organization offer a variety of ways for women to live out their faith in an inclusive, caring community. For more than 200 years PW groups have strengthened the Presbyterian Church and played a major role in sharing the good news of Jesus Christ and witnessing to the promise of God's kingdom.

Women’s groups in the Presbyterian Church have a powerful history. Since the early 1800s Presbyterian women have organized themselves to support mission and combat social injustices nationally and internationally. While the levels of involvement and recognition from the denominations has varied, women’s dedication to living out God’s call through women’s organizations has remained steady.

Presbyterian Women is a church-wide group organized at all levels of the PC(USA). Like the PC(USA) structure, PW in the Congregations form the basis for PW in the Presbytery; PW in the Presbytery feeds into PW in the Synod, and so on. Presbyterian Women was formed with the merger of United Presbyterian Women (UPCUSA) and Women of the Church (PCUS), following the reunion of the church in 1988.
