Position Title	Youth Ministry Leader (part time)
Supervisor	Pastor (Dr. Philip Gladden)
Liaisons	Christian Education Ministry Team
Responsibility	The Youth Ministry Leader develops programming for youth ministry to enhance the discipleship experience of families and young people through fellowship, study, worship, and service, including opportunities for intergenerational worship, education, and mission.
Ministry Values	Our Youth and Family Ministry aims to nurture and educate our children and youth in: Knowing God and God's Word Involving themselves in friends and fellowship Developing a Christian community of children, youth and adults who enjoy a life together as a family and who are committed to their faith and each other Serving in church and community

The Youth Ministry Leader will:

- Build relationships with youth and their families, supporting and encouraging them through personal contact and interest. This requires a willingness to participate in the life of the church outside youth programming. This also would include communication with youth and parents through social media, personal calls, and text messages.
- Seek to increase participation within the youth programs by reaching out to the WPC family and the community outside the church.
- Participate in Sunday worship services and encourage and coordinate youth involvement in those services.
- Direct weekly youth group meetings in cooperation with adult volunteers. Programs include Bible study, discussion groups, worship, service projects, and fellowship events.
- Coordinate volunteers to work with youth and work closely with those adult volunteers, equipping them to assist in youth programming.
- Plan fellowship events for youth including planned activities that occur outside of weekly youth group or Sunday morning Sunday school.
- Plan and lead opportunities for youth service to the community and missions.
- Lead youth in special events, such as those offered by the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina (e.g., Montreat Youth Conference, Triennium, presbytery retreats).
- Coordinate WPC family and youth-related social media communication and website.
- Work with Second Sunday leaders to involve youth in that program.
- Be youth program leader for the annual church Sound Retreat.
- Abide by the church's Sexual Misconduct Policy and Child Safety Policy and undergo a criminal background check.
